We are pleased to invite you to the half-day workshop of the eFoodChain initiative that will be hosted by the Dutch Ministry of Economic Affairs and will take place on the 27 of June in the Hague, Netherlands.

The eFoodChain project is an European initiative (funded by the DG Enterprise, European Commission) for the agro-food industry, promoting innovative use of ICT for better integration of companies into digital supply chains. The project has been developing a collaborative Reference Framework for the digital agro-food supply chain, which sets the principles and rules for interoperability among business processes and data exchange models in order to allow for paperless and standardised data flows, facilitating B2B transactions, especially for its smaller players.

Currently the eFoodChain consortium is setting the stage for the demonstration and validation of the eFoodChain Reference Framework and a group of "Innovators and Early Adopters" participating in the pilot implementations will benefit of the proposed solution and exploit the innovative potential of standardized digital data exchanges. At this moment the first phase of the pilot scheme has initiated, and its second phase is being prepared and envisages extending the demonstration scope geographically and involving a larger number of participants.

We believe this action might be of interest to you and we look forward to meet you and discuss the eFoodChain initative in person on the 27 of June, when we will present the project outcomes until now and future opportunities it may offer to your organisation. In the meantime we remain at your disposal for providing further details or clarifying any question that may arise.
