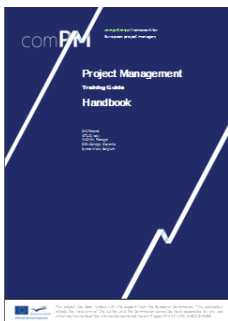

ComPM Training Programme!

Based on the Competence profile of EU Project Managers, a training curriculum has been defined comprising six modules aiming at developing the required competences and focusing on the several phases of a project implementation, as follows:



Module 1) Project framework: focuses on the Identification Phase in which a project is scoped;

Module 2) Project planning: focuses on the phase of a project life-cycle called project planning;

Module 3) Financial management: focuses on financial management of a project

Module 4) Project marketing and communication: focuses on the marketing and communication actions within a EU project

Module 5) Project monitoring and evaluation: focuses on the monitoring and evaluation as an integral part of the daily project management.

Module 6) Supporting skills: focuses on the soft skills that need to be acted during the different project phases.

Partners Meetings!



ComPM partners meet in Ljubljana, Slovenia, in April and also in Milan, Italy in September for internal project meetings. In Slovenia, partners presented the contents of the various modules of the ComPM training programme and agreed on improvements to include. As for the meeting in Milan, the consortium promoted the train-the-trainer session, in which trainers from each partner country had the opportunity to know in detail each module to be later delivered in the pilot courses. These meetings are important events to allow partners deciding on future actions of the project.
